- planned for 4% decrease \$400k in funding based on change in government

- Grade 12's in Social 30 will be hosting a debate for MP's this Friday

7. Principal's report on new ABJ Flex Block and new Tech Policy.

Greg Lakeman - Tech Policy

- used as a tool to support learning (students require Google for classroom)
- there are a few hard wired pc's available for students in the library
- students need to ensure the devices are charged before school
- no need to buy top of the line laptop, a chrome book or tablet work fine
- phones: all must be put in the cell phone hotel, hotel rooms are numbered
- students can use phones in learning common, or lower common area
- prevents students from using phones in washrooms or walking around in hallways
- teachers were exhausted from having to constantly ask students to put away phones
- mirrors the regulations in other Sherwood Park high schools

Joe Dumont - Flex Block

- students can choose how they invest their time for learning
 - a) academic support eg. math help, projects b) health/wellness eg. fitness, spiritual
- teacher meeting opportunities/ regular collaboration with other teachers
- challenge: attendance 1 hour end of day Wednesdays
- kids can choose, but parents can also place the student in a specific session
- opportunity to use flex block as a make-up class eg. missed class due to assembly
- gr 12's get a chance to meet with teachers to help ensure all courses are fulfilled to graduate as well as help reduce anxiety about where they will go/what they will do after they graduate

• Questions from parents:

Q: what is the buy in? A: first week we only had 30 students stay but teachers expect this to increase quickly as students have more assignments

Q: will yellow bus transportation change? A: no

Q: city bus extremely overcrowded on flex day A: county is looking into the situation

Q: why are kids leaving? A: if you want your student to stay, sign them up for a session, or hopefully they make that decision on their own

Q: what if study hall gets too full? A: we will continue to accept session ideas from students/parents

Upper common area - could be used to teach a larger group eg. fitness

- preventing kids from hanging out in an unsupervised location
- it has made a difference for teachers not having to police the students who were not making good choices eg, vaping in washrooms, cell phone use
