Division Theme & Social Justice Goal

This year our Division theme is *Challenge Accepted*. Our division has *accepted the challenge* of supporting Valeda House as our large scale social justice project for our community. Valeda House supports women and families in the Edmonton area (including Sherwood Park and the County of Strathcona) in providing supports of temporary shelters for homeless women who may face exceptional challenges in finding safe housing. This is a safe and secure environment that is alcohol and drug free, non-smoking and no pets.

How To Support Your Child And Connect With The School

Another effective tool available to **parents/ guardians 24/7 is the ability to monitor grades and assignments** using PowerSchool. Teachers are expected to have grades inputted for all assessments within 2 weeks of completion of the work. Many of teachers are diligent in posting marks much sooner that the 2 week maximum. All families should now have functional PowerSchool usernames and passwords for students and parents in Grade 9-12 to better monitor student progress.
