



It is expected that all students at Archbishop Jordan be responsible for creating and assessing their individual myPass accounts. MyPass is an Alberta Education self-service website set up for Alberta students to:

- View diploma exam results and request rescues
- Register to write a diploma exam
- Order High School transcripts
- View progress towards a credential (diploma or certificate)
- View and print a Detailed Academic Report (DAR)
- View student personal information

How do I register?

1. Google **myPass** or go to <https://public.education.alberta.ca/PASI/myPass>
2. To register for an account, you will need
 - your Alberta Student Number (**ASN**) this is the longer 9-digit number on your ABJ student ID card
 - a personal **email** address (**do not use your school email**)
 - your date of birth
3. Set up an Education Account
4. Google may be used to create the Alberta Education Account: students must enter their email, click “I’m new, sign me up!” and select “Sign Up”
Check your email for a confirmation link after you have created your Education Account. Select the link to confirm the creation of your Education Account. You will then enter in a screen name and a password. You can then select “Finish” **Record** your username and password in a safe place. You will be using this account throughout your High School, so please don’t lose your log in information – it is not easy to reset!
5. Conversely, if you do not sign up for your myPass account through Google, you will be prompted to request an Access Code. This code will be sent to your home address and will arrive within 5-10 business days. Once the code arrives, you can authenticate your account from there. Please note, the code expires within 30 days of its arrival, so please set up your account as soon as you receive it!

Third Party Access

Parents/guardians may access your myPass account as well. Process looks the same, however, third party will use their own email. They will need to provide the student’s ASN and date of birth upon registration.

3. Either sign in with your Google/Microsoft/GOA username/password and go to step 7

OR

4. Fill in your email. **DO NOT use your ABJ Email address.** Use a personal email like Gmail
5. Click "I'm new, sign me up"
6. Click "SIGNUP"

9. Your last screen will look like this:

Signup Access Code Successfully Requested

The following are the steps that must occur in order for you to gain access:

1. A letter that contains the signup access code is mailed to your most recent mailing address that Alberta Education has on file for you.
2. The letter usually arrives in 2-3 business days but may take up to 2 weeks depending on Canada Post's mail service.
3. Please return to myPass.alberta.ca to request connection.
4. Use the Signup access code to establish your connection.

You are finished for now. You will need to wait for Alberta Education to mail you a Signup Access Code. Don't forget to watch your mail delivery for an envelope addressed to you from Alberta Education.

10. Once you receive your letter in the mail, you can finish the steps to creating your myPass Account. You will notice that the PIN will expire soon so you need to activate it right away!
11. Go to myPass.alberta.ca like in step 1 above. Click Sign in with Education Account.
12. Sign in to your account the same way you did in step 3 or 4 above. Either with your Google/Microsoft/GOA username/password or email/password you created before.
13. This time you will click "Yes" you received a Signup Access Code.
14. You will be directed to the next screen that will allow you to enter your Access Code. Follow the direction to complete the process.

What can I use my account for?

Detailed Academic Report

Your main page on myPass will look like this once you have logged in. Select "**Detailed Academic Report**" (DAR). Click on that and you will then be able to Download it as a PDF. This will be your unofficial transcript. It shows your course history, your marks, your credits earned, essentially a complete snapshot of your academic history beginning from Grade 10.
