



## **ABJ Student Attire Policy**

Archbishop Jordan Catholic High School Student Dress Code Committee is proposing the following **ABJ Student Attire Policy** for consideration:

Students recognize we are in a respectful, faith based educational environment, and therefore must take this into consideration when dressing ourselves from day to day. We are a catholic high school, we have the ability and the opportunity to express ourselves, but we must also remember where we are and must be reasonable with what we wear.

### **Student will consider the following guidelines when dressing for school:**

- *Hats can be worn, but will be taken off during prayer/mass*
- *Your bra must be covered, except for bra straps, which may be visible*
- *No offensive slogans or depictions will be tolerated on clothing*
- *No underwear can be shown and shorts must cover the buttocks*
- *Tank tops cannot have armholes that expose the chest and back*
- *Crop tops are allowed, but cannot be higher than the belly button (if the midriff is uncovered)*
- *Camisoles/tank tops/bandeaus must be worn underneath sheer shirts*

These guidelines will be respected by students and enforced by staff and administration so as to continue to uphold the respectful, faith based environment that has been created in our school, and to ensure that all students feel comfortable within our school.
