 - -Percentage of Students Transitioning to Post-Secondary Education 20% above provincial average.
- Archbishop Jordan maintains an excellent rating for being a safe and caring environment.
- 100% of students achieved acceptable standard in English Language Arts 30-2 and French Language Arts 30-1.
- Math 30-2, Biology 30 & Physics 30 demonstrated significant improvement.
- Social Studies 30-2 students achieving standard of excellence were 20% above the provincial average.
