## Course Registration Procedures

### Checklist:

- If I am choosing to select Advanced Placement (AP) courses, I have met the specific academic entrance average requirements as listed in the ABJ Handbook.
- I have not chosen courses that could possibly be removed due to not passing the prerequisite course. In other words, if you are on the bubble of passing your course at this time, it is highly likely that you will struggle in the same stream of course next year.
- I am aware that selecting anything listed as O/S means “Off-Schedule” and that class will occur outside the regular timetable and will plan accordingly for it.
- I have listed two alternate Compliment Courses, to be used only in the case of a conflict or inability to schedule other options.
- Any courses that I would like to take that aren’t listed on my grade level sheet, I have written in order of preference in the Additional Course Requests section of the Registration Form on the bottom right column.
- I have consulted with my subject specific teachers to determine the appropriate course selection for the next level.
- I have consulted with my parents/guardians and had them sign at the appropriate location.

For verification purposes, we will be confirming that you have met the proper recommended prerequisites so please make sure that you are choosing your courses wisely and accurately. Schedules will be **automatically adjusted and modified, without consultation**, accordingly.
